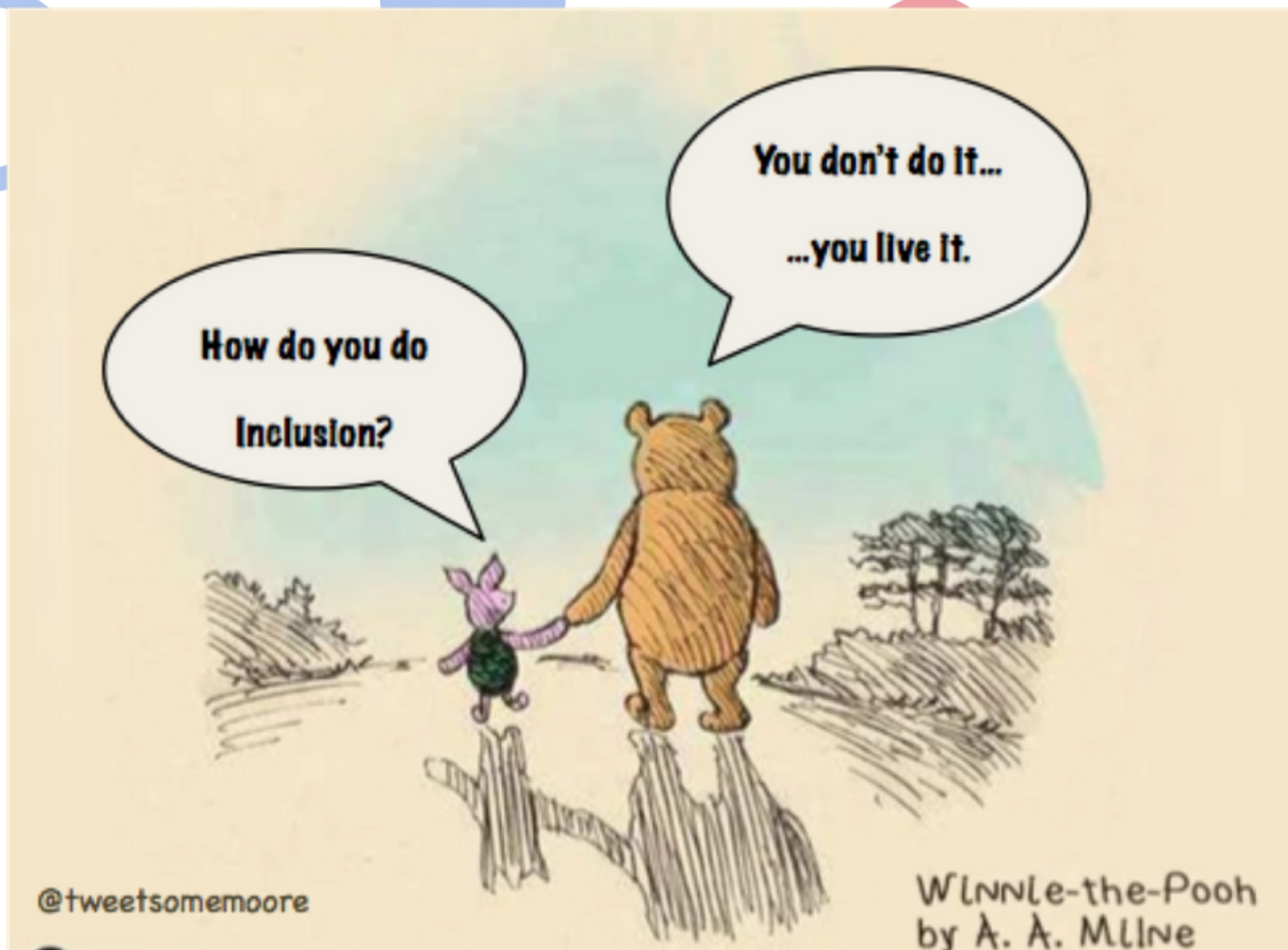


Where are you on this continuum? What's the next step?
